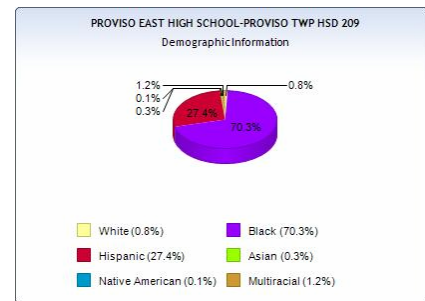

Graduation Requirements

English (4)

Students must complete two credits in writing-intensive courses. This is not an additional credit requirement. This requirement will be met through designated courses in the English department, and in other departments, if those courses are designated as writing-intensive.

Reading (0.5)

Mathematics (3)

(Must include one credit in algebra and one credit in geometry)

Science (2)

(Must include one credit in biological science and one credit in physical science, excluding the freshman science course)

Social Studies (2)

(Must include one credit in World History and one credit in U.S. History, plus successful examinations on the Illinois and U.S. Constitutions)

Consumer Education (0.5)

(May be satisfied by state proficiency test)

Physical Education (4)

(Must include one-half credit in Health Education and 30 hours in Driver Education — Students may take NJROTC and Freshman Marching Band to earn Physical Education credit.)

Fine Arts (0.5)

(Art, Music, Contemporary Humanities, Film as Humanities, Drama)

Applied Sciences (0.5)

(Applied Technology, Business Education, Family and Consumer Sciences)

Academic Core Electives (3)

(English, World Languages, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies)

Other Electives (2)

(World Languages, Art, Music, or Applied Sciences, Keyboarding)
