

PROVISO EAST HIGH SCHOOL CLASS OF 1956 ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP

**Guidelines for the Applicant
Due Date: Monday, April 30, 2012**

This one-time scholarship in the maximum amount of \$3,000.00 (maximum \$1,500.00 per term) is funded by the Class of 1956. This scholarship shall be awarded to a National Honor Society senior, graduating in June 2012, for financial assistance with tuition. The award will be made at Class Day. The money will not be paid to the recipient, but directly to the junior college, college, or university after enrollment and attendance are verified.



The following are requirements for application:

1. The applicant must be a graduating senior National Honor Society member and a U. S. citizen.
2. Applicants must meet requirements of scholarship, character, leadership, and purpose. Applicants must have a high scholastic standing as measured by their grade point average (minimum Of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale or equivalent), class rank, and standardized test scores.
3. The applicant must be accepted for admission to an accredited junior college, college, or university.
4. The applicant intends to be a full-time student. Tuition fees per term will be paid directly to the school after enrollment and attendance are verified.
5. Study must be leading to an Associate or Bachelor degree at an accredited junior college, college, or university.
6. To apply for a scholarship, the applicant must return the documents listed under #7 below to the NHS sponsor by Monday, April 30, 2012.
7. Documents required by the applicant:
 - A. Completed application form
 - B. List of school and community activities
 - C. Paragraphs detailing education and career plans
 - D. Current transcript
 - E. Copy of letter of acceptance from your chosen school
 - F. Applicant must maintain a minimum 3.00 GPA to receive the second semester funding. In the event the student is unable to begin the second term, the \$1,500.00 will roll over to 2013, using the same criteria as in this document.
 - G. Letters of recommendation from THREE of the following five choices below:
 - *Either #1 or #2 must be one of the three letters.
 - (1.) *High school guidance counselor or administrator
 - (2.) *Teacher
 - (3.) Business or professional person
 - (4.) Employer
 - (5.) Clergyman
